



**Scenario:** You are getting your newspaper from the mailbox when you hear shooting coming from an advancing car. As you retreat to the cover of your car you tell your neighbor to take cover. You neutralize the targets outside then head inside to check your family. You find that some of the thugs made it inside also.

**Procedure:** Start loaded and holstered facing uprange at Position A with newspaper in strong hand. On signal move to cover at Pos. B. On the way to cover you MUST knock over the popper to activate the swinger. Once reaching cover at Pos. B you MUST put the newspaper in the box, all with strong hand as this is for safety. Shooter should then be facing downrange and may draw and engage swinger, T2 & T3. Shooter then moves to position C utilizing cover and engage T4, T5 & T6 and then enter doorway at Pos. D and finish by engaging T7, T8 & T9. All targets are 2 rounds minimum and must be shot in “Tactical Priority” and as you see them for Pos. D. Tactical Priority means that targets are engaged in order of threat posed, ie. near to far.
